
Some situations call for spontaneity and playful digression, for example; others call for near-exact repetition of a revered text.

Insert your own css file called custom.css file into: Styling > Themes > Custom CSS Upload.


After that click on custom.css and choose "edit code" and you can insert your own css into it by using the Visual Studio editor online!

In this example i have insert the Google fonts called “Fira Sans” and others to test.
In the css i insert
