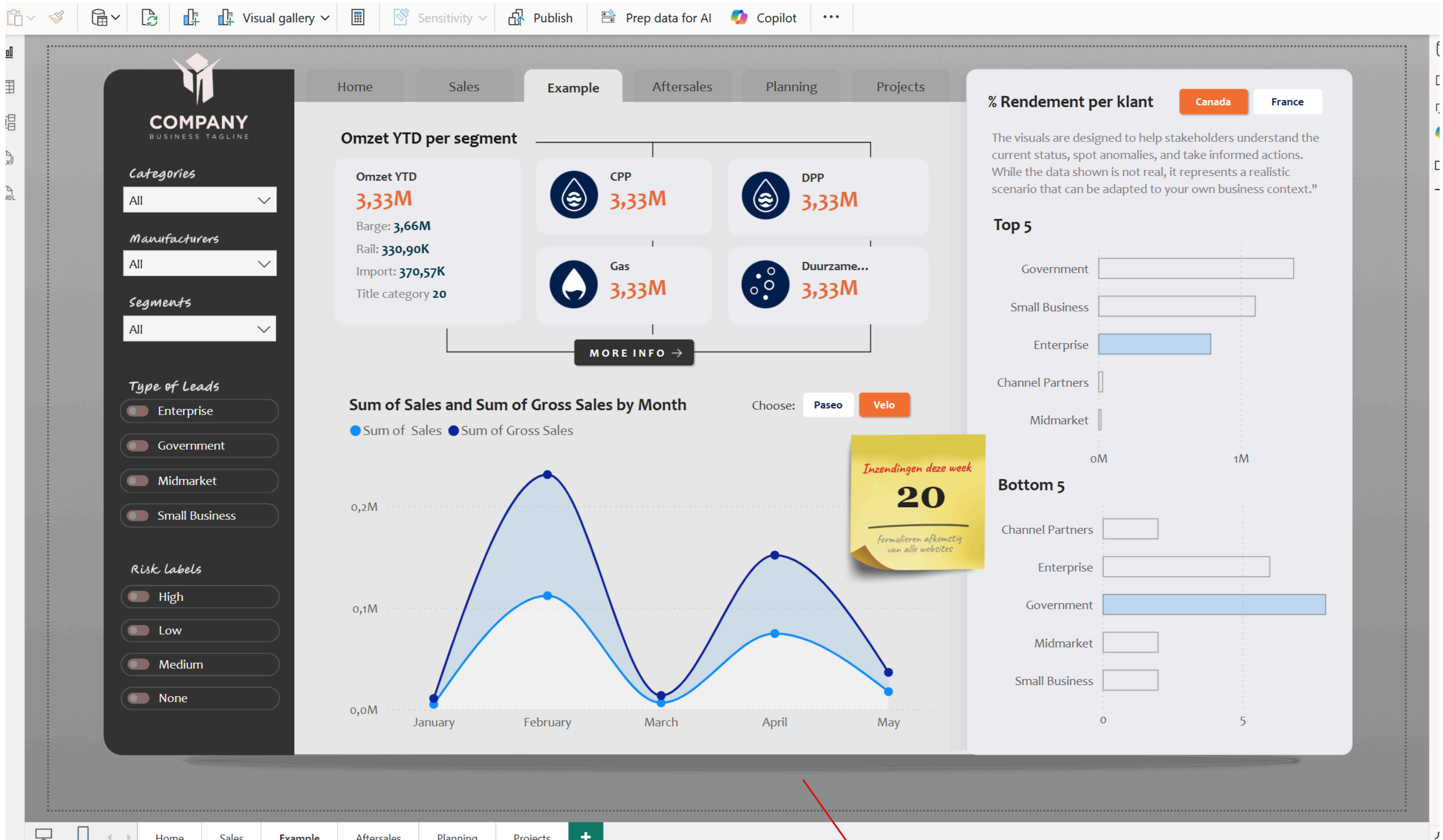

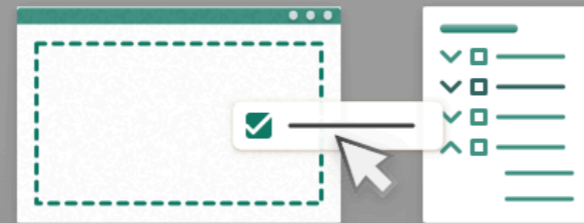


Let's create a look and feel like this
